Port and vessel information for vessels currently in Australian ports

1) Click on **The List** menu option and then choose the **Vessels in Port** menu option

8) As with **Search by Port** this will open up another window with our search results. You will see the name of our search at the top of the screen

9) We can lose any columns of data that we are not interested in by simply clicking on the tick box, such as next port and then clicking on **Filter Results**. **De-select All** will unselect all fields

10) To undo this operation you can click the **UnFilter Results** button

11) We can also sort the search results by column. Simply click on the top of the column you wish to sort and it will order that column for you. Click again and it will reverse the order of the data

- 12) Let's say we want to export all of these search results to PDF. Simply click on **View PDF Report**, then open. You can print by clicking on the print icon or select file/print/then ok
- 13) If you have an A3 printer then the **View A3 PDF Report** will be helpful for you, again click the view A3 PDF report button and print, making sure that you have chosen your printer set-up correctly
- 14) To manipulate the data further, we recommend viewing in a CSV or spreadsheet report; simply click on the **View CSV Spreadsheet Report** button; click on open and manipulate the data as you wish. You can print from excel too.
