All ports of call for a particular vessel

1) Click on **The List** menu option and then choose the **Vessels in Port** menu option

- 3) This will open up another window with our search results and you will see the name of our search at the top of the screen
- 4) We can lose any columns of data that we are not interested in by simply clicking on the tick box, such as Departure Date and then clicking on **Filter Results**
- 5) To undo this operation you can click the **UnFilter Results** button

6) We can also sort the search results by column. Simply click on the top of the column you wish to sort and it will order that column for you. Click again and it will reverse the order of the data

7) To export these results to PDF simply click on **View PDF Report**, then open. You can print by clicking on the print icon or select file/print/then ok

8) To manipulate the data further, we recommend viewing in a CSV or spreadsheet report; simply click on the **View CSV Spreadsheet** report button; click on open and manipulate the data as you wish. You can print from excel too
